Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.1. The Bride's Pride (Gold Bridal Jewellery of the year)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must be made primarily of gold only with or without precious and semi-precious stones & can be of various gold colors above 200 Grams in 22Kt or in 18Kt only
- All the Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be wearable in nature by brides as part of the bridal attire
- The Jewellery can be of traditional type or ethno-contemporary style
- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must have minimum 3 pieces of ornaments in any combination (e.g. necklace with pair of earrings or waistband with a pair of earrings) and should be of the same theme/ design
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.2 The Bride's Pride (Diamond Bridal Jewellery of the Year)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must be primarily made of diamond in gold of 22kt or 18kt or 14kt or platinum and should be above 20 carats of diamond
- The Jewellery piece can include precious and semi-precious stones, color stones & can be of various gold colors or uncut diamonds in gold and platinum
- All the Jewellery pieces must be a wearable in nature by brides as part of the bridal attire . The Jewellery can be of traditional type or ethno-contemporary style
- The Jewellery pieces submitted for under this category must have minimum 3 pieces of ornaments in any combination (e.g. necklace with pair of earrings or waistband with a pair of earrings) and should be of the same theme/ design
- All the Jewellery submitted for this award category should be wearable in nature
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category

1.3 A Match made in heaven (Couple Jewellery for his and her)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must be made primarily of gold or any other precious metal only with or without precious and semi-precious stones
- The Jewellery piece submitted under this category must be ornaments for male and female of the same theme and design (e.g. rings, bracelets, pendants, etc.)
- The jewellery piece should be for couples to represent their love and togetherness
- The designs submitted under this category shall be wearable in nature. Article accessories shall not be considered and will get disqualified (e.g. mobile covers, keychains, etc.)
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category

1.4 Showstopper couture (Contemporary Gold Jewellery)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be primarily made of gold in various gold colors (22kt or 18kt only) with/without enameling, without the use of any other metals or stones
- The Jewellery piece can be of modern type or contemporary design and should be party wear
- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must have minimum 3 pieces of ornaments (e.g. necklace with pair of earrings)
- All design of the jewelry sets submitted (any combination i.e. necklace and pair of earrings, pair of earrings and ring, etc.) should be of the same theme/design
- All the Jewellery submitted for this award category should be wearable in nature and represent modern women

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be primarily made of gold in various gold colors (22kt or 18kt only) with/without enameling, without the use of any other metals or stones
- The Jewellery piece can be of modern type or contemporary design and should be party wear
- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must have minimum 3 pieces of ornaments (e.g. necklace with pair of earrings)
- All design of the jewelry sets submitted (any combination i.e. necklace and pair of earrings, pair of earrings and ring, etc.) should be of the same theme/design
- All the Jewellery submitted for this award category should be wearable in nature and represent modern women

1.5 Showstopper couture(Contemporary Diamond Jewelry)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be primarily made of diamond in gold (22kt, 14kt, or 18kt only) with/without the use of kundan or stones.
- The Jewellery can be of modern type or contemporary design and should be party wear
- The Jewellery pieces submitted for under this category must have minimum 3 pieces of ornaments (e.g. necklace with pair of earrings)
- All design of the jewelry sets submitted (any combination i.e. necklace and pair of earrings, pair of earrings and ring, etc.) should be of the same theme/design and wearable in nature
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category

1.6 Paramparik jewelry - An artisan's pride

- The Jewellery piece submitted under this category must be made of gold/ gold with uncut diamonds, kundan and gemstones (precious / semi-precious) and must have an essence of Indian heritage and ethnicity
- The designs should be inspired from or symbolic of a bygone era – (Mughal, Victorian, Rajputana, etc.)
- It should have an essence of timeless elegance – an heirloom piece which can be passed down generations
- Necklace sets (including earrings), kangans, hair accessory, arm and waist bands. are eligible to apply under this category
- All the Jewellery submitted under this category should be wearable in nature
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted only one entry will be considered for the awards category

1.7 The New - Age Women's Jewellery (9 to 5 Jewellery - Gold)

- The Jewellery piece must be a fashionably elegant and comfortable that can be worn by women in day to day endeavors
- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be primarily made of gold
- The Jewellery piece can include precious and semi-precious stones, color stones & can be of various gold colors
- The Jewellery piece submitted for the awards should be of max 30 gms only. In case of multiple pieces submitted each jewellery piece should be of 30gms
- The jewellery piece submitted should be suitable for modern & traditional women who is stylist and discerning and fancies lighter piece of jewellery
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category

1.8 The New – Age Women’s Jewellery (9 to 5 Jewellery – Diamond)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be primarily made of diamond in gold or platinum
- The Jewellery piece can include uncut diamonds in gold or platinum
- The Jewellery piece must be a fashionably elegant and comfortable that can be worn by women in day to day life
- The Jewellery piece submitted should be suitable for modern & traditional women who is stylist and discerning and fancies lighter piece of Jewellery
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.9 The Touch of Color (Colourstone Jewellery of the Year)

- The necklace jewellery set(s) in this category should be primarily made of gold and set with colored precious /semi-precious stones/CZ stones & uncut diamond/chakri stones, beads and pearls with or without enameling
- All the Jewellery submitted for this award category should be wearable in nature
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.10 Treasure of Ocean (Pearl Jewellery of the Year)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should be primarily made of pearl in precious metal only
- The Jewellery piece can be of traditional or modern contemporary style
- The jewellery design should have creative use of pearls with fantastic design and should be wearable in nature
- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category should not be more than 3 pieces of ornaments (e.g. necklace with pair of earrings)
- All design of the jewellery sets submitted (any combination i.e. necklace and earrings, earrings and kangans, etc.) should be of the same theme/design
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.11 The Platinum Bond of Love (Platinum Jewellery of the Year)

- The Jewellery piece submitted for this award should be primarily made of platinum
- Any jewelry which is made of platinum studded with or without precious stones is eligible for participation in this category. Necklace set (including earrings), chains, rings, earring sets, bangles, pendent/ pendent sets (including earrings) are eligible for participation under this category
- The pieces submitted should be aesthetically appealing and practically wearable. Besides it must also have fantastic design, impressive finish and remarkable craftsmanship
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.12 Sterling Silver Jewellery (Silver Jewellery of the Year)

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must be made in 925 sterling silver only
- Any Jewellery which is primarily made of silver with or without precious, semi-precious stones, diamond, color stones, pearls, coral, beads with/without enamel work are eligible to participate in this category
- The Jewellery can be of any styling or fashion but should be wearable in nature
- Only one Jewellery piece/ pair of ornament can be submitted under this category
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category

1.13 Sterling Silver Artifacts

- The pieces submitted under this category must be made purely in 925 sterling silver The article should be non-wearable in nature
- The article design under this category can be utensils, idols, kitchenware and decorative items
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the pieces submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.14 All Eyes on HIM (Men's Jewellery of the Year)

- The Jewellery piece participating under this category must be specifically designed for men
- The Jewellery can be made of precious metals such as gold, platinum and precious, semi-precious stones, diamonds, uncut diamond
- Other materials such as rubber, leather and ceramics can be used to enhance the look of the product
- The Jewellery designs submitted must complement appeal to the fashion sensibilities of the present day's Indian men
- Jewellery piece can be of styling or fashion but must be wearable in nature. The jewellery piece participating under this category shouldn't be article jewellery
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.15 Accessory of the Year

- The Jewellery pieces submitted under this category must be made of precious metal such as gold or platinum, with or without precious, non-precious stones, diamond, color stones, pearls, coral, beads with/without enamel work are eligible to participate in this category
- The Jewellery should be an accessory and used for styling or fashion but should be wearable in nature
- The jewellery design can either for men or women and should have remarkable design
- Only one Jewellery piece/ pair of ornament can be submitted under this category
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Jewellery Award SEGMENT I

1.16 Innovative Jewellery of the Year – A designer's dream

- Jewellery designs made of precious metals demonstrating innovative strength, distinctive visual appeal, manufactured using unique and innovative technology
- Besides making a style statement, the hall mark of this shortlisted Jewellery piece should be the Inspiration of its innovative streak and design quotient
- It must also possess good design and craftsmanship that would by definition make it unique in character
- The participant should only submit picture of the design. The sketches of the design will not be accepted and will be disqualified from the awards
- The participant can submit multiples entries provided the design of the Jewellery submitted is different. In case of multiple entries with the same design submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



Excellence Award SEGMENT 2

2.1 Advertising Campaign of the Year – Print

- The entries submitted under this category should be an advertising campaign for jewellery store in print medium such as newspaper, magazine, journals, etc.
- The campaign idea should be innovative and unique and campaign should clearly highlight its objective, execution strategy, its impact and results
- The entry must highlight the unique features, if any, of the campaign

2.2 Advertising Campaign of the Year – Audio Visual

- The entries submitted under this category should be an advertising campaign for jewellery store in audio/visual medium such as television, radio, etc.
- The campaign idea should be innovative and unique and campaign should clearly highlight its objective, execution strategy, its impact and results
- The entry must highlight the unique features, if any, of the campaign

2.3 Digital/ Social Media Campaign of the year

- To recognize specialized retailers/manufacturers/wholesalers who have effectively built a promotion campaign to tap into social medium by designing innovative website/application on social media platforms aimed to enhanced sales
- The jury panel for this category will include renowned web designers and senior personnel from ecommerce businesses



Store Award SEGMENT 3

3.1 Retail Chain of the year

To recognize a retail chain (this consists of minimum 10 or more retail outlets in India) with the most innovative concept. The concept should have been successful in enhancing product display and footfalls. For this category, one or more of the following criteria will be used to shortlist and determine the winners:

- Aesthetics of the store (interiors, lighting, environment, display etc.)
- Creativity & Innovation
- Customer Service
- Visual Merchandising

Please note - The selection panel will be renowned interior designers, HR grooming trainers and visual merchandisers.

3.2 Single Store of the Year

Recognize the most innovative concept for a single store set up in North, Central –East, West and South of India. The concept should have been successful in enhancing product display and footfalls. For this category, one or more of the following criteria will be used to shortlist and determine the winners

- Aesthetics of the store (interiors, lighting, environment, display etc.)
- Creativity & Innovation
- Customer Service

Designer & Artisan Award **SEGMENT 4**

4.1 Designer – CAD

This category is to acknowledge CAD Jewellery designers based on the design aesthetics, finesse and proportion. Rendering of the product on the software must be exceptional and the design must be feasible to manufacture and wear. The participant is allowed to submit only one design for the category, multiple entries of same or different design will not be accepted

One or more of the following evaluation criteria to be used by the Jury:

- Workmanship and Skills
- Design aesthetics & Innovation
- Feasibility and Practicality of design

4.2 Designer - Hand sketch

This category aims to award the designer with the most aesthetic hand sketched design of Jewellery piece. The Jewellery designs must be feasible to manufacture and should be wearable. The designers who were finalists in the last edition of awards can't apply for the awards. The participant is allowed to submit only one design for the category, multiple entries of same or different design will not be accepted

One or more of the following evaluation criteria to be used by the Jury:

- Workmanship and skills
- Design aesthetics & Innovation
- Feasibility and Practicality of design

4.3 Designer – Artisan/Craftsman

- This category aims to award the artisan/craftsman with the most outstanding design of Jewellery piece. The fineness and finishing of the Jewellery designs must be of high standards and should be wearable.
- Winners of this category will be awarded with cash prizes. The participant is allowed to submit only one design for the category, multiple entries of same or different design will not be accepted



Student of the Year Award **SEGMENT 5**

5.1 Student of the Year Award

- Any individual who is currently studying in a Jewellery designing institute (May or may not be affiliated to any other body/board) can participate for these Awards
- The Jewellery design submitted must be innovative, novel and extraordinary. It must be technically viable to manufacture and must be wearable with ease and comfort
- The student is allowed to submit only one design for the category. Multiple entries of same or different design will not be accepted
- The award will be given to the top 10 applications received

Segment 6 – Corporate Social Responsibility Award

- This award will be given to an individual / firm from the Gems & Jewellery Industry, who has contributed towards the upliftment of the society
- The participant needs to submit initiative/project/service submitted under this category which should be completely executed and fully implemented in the period of Apr 1, 2017 to Mar 31, 2018
- The initiative/project/service submitted under this category should demonstrate a measurable impact on the society and other stakeholders in the period of Apr 1, 2017 to Mar 31, 2018
- The participant should support their entry with relevant pictures/images/documents etc
- The participant can submit multiple entries provided the initiative/project/service is different. In case of multiple entries with the same initiative/project/service submitted, only one entry will be considered for the awards category



National Jewellery Awards 2018

Terms & Conditions:

- Entire Jewellery Fraternity (The Jewellery fraternities include Retailers, Wholesalers, Manufacturers, e-commerce entity, Designers and Gold smiths.) across India can apply for the National Jewellery Awards 2018
- Designs/Jewellery which is manufactured in the year 2016-2018 can only take part. Entries that do not comply with any of these rules will be disqualified.
- All the jewellery applied under National Jewellery Awards 2018 should have certificate of authenticity. Participants will be asked to submit the certification at any point of time during the awards process
- Jewellery design/pieces or stores or marketing activities for jewellery promotion awarded in any other jewellery awards held in Apr 2017 to March 2018 period will not be eligible to apply for National Jewellery Awards and if found will be disqualified from the awards
- The Top 2 participants for Karigar award will receive cash prize
- Top finalists of Designer – Hand-sketch category from previous editions of National Jewellery Awards are not eligible to apply for the awards. If found at any stage, will be disqualified from the awards
- It is explicitly understood that the entry details are approved and overseen by the owner /partner/ director of the company
- Application fees is not refundable. The discount is applicable on the entry count per invoice. Sum total of Multiple invoice entries will not be accounted in the discount pattern.
- Kindly issue the Cheque or Demand draft or NEFT or RTGS on the name of "All India Gems & Jewellery Domestic Council"
- At the time of submitting the application, please ensure that you have provided all the necessary details. Please make a note that incomplete applications will not be accepted
- All the supporting materials wherever necessary should be specifically attached with the entries
- One Jewellery piece/ set/ pair/ design can participate in one category only. Similar designs, if found will be disqualified from the awards
- Winners of the previous editions of NJA are not eligible to participate with the winning jewellery piece/ set
- The Jewellery has to be 100% manufactured in India to participate in the National Jewellery Awards 2018
- For applying in student category the participant should have completed 18 years of age as on October 31, 2018
- In case there is a dispute with a particular Jewellery design, then the manufacturer has to prove that he has designed that particular Jewellery piece. The decision of the NJA Awards committee will be final and binding
- The third party process Auditor shall monitor the system process of NJA 2018 Program
- You are requested to-cooperate with the NJA Awards committee on the deadlines for submission of material/jewellery for smooth operations
- The Jury of the NJA 2018 shall have the final authority in determining the winner of the awards. The decision of the Jury shall be final, conclusive and binding, the winner or any other person shall have no legal or any other rights to contest or dispute the decision of the jury
- GJF shall not be legally liable for any loss and or damage arising for any reason whatsoever regarding the National Jewellery Awards 2018

- Please submit photographs of finished jewellery or sketches only. Size of photographs must be 8*10 inches only
- The Award categories may be changed / modified / split / merged / increased or cancelled by the Jury based on the number and quality of entries received in each category. Awards management / jury may apply minimum cap for the category to be awarded to maintain high standards of Awards. This is at the discretion of Awards management / Jury and this cannot be contested in any manner
- In the event that no Participant in a category are found to be worthy of inclusion by the Jury, the Award category may be cancelled by the Jury. The Jury may decide to add organizations in the category to maintain high standards of participation. The decision of the Jury in this regard will be final and non-contestable. The Awards management will not entertain any queries in this regard
- The Jewellery applied for the Awards should be: Commercially available Original design
- Meet the category requirements (General and Specific) for each category in which it is entered. The category requirements are set forth below. Designs/Jewellery which is manufactured in the year 2018 can only take part. Entries that do not comply with any of these rules will be disqualified
- By submitting your entry, you grant organizer the right and license to reproduce, publish, distribute, and display your entry materials, and portions thereof, in any of its publications in all media, and advertising the same, and you represent and warrant:
- That the work depicted in your entry is your entry is your own original creation, that organizer's use and publication of your entry materials will not infringe upon or otherwise violate any copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, or other intellectual property right, any right of publicity, privacy, or other personal right or any law, rule, or regulation
- That the information provided on your payment form and entry form is accurate and complete
